- QUESTION THAT CAME UP AT ONLINE USERS GROUP MEETING 3/27/85 -- Connee Wetthey

Those of you who attended the March Online Users Group Meeting may remember that a question came up regarding the use of both the major designator and a subheading simultaneously on Dialog. I spoke to Penny, Dialog's Medline expert, and her answer is, "DON'T DO IT!" She recommends using two separate search statements if you must do it, in order not to lose retrieval you might want. (But first, the way I told you to designate a major heading no longer works on Dialog 2. It is now the heading with /maj attached to it instead of /df\*. You may want to correct the chart I distributed.)

For example:

SS 1 OBESITY/MAJ  
SS 2 OBESITY(L)SU  
SS 3 C 1 AND 2

Rather than OBESITY/MAJ(L)SU

or

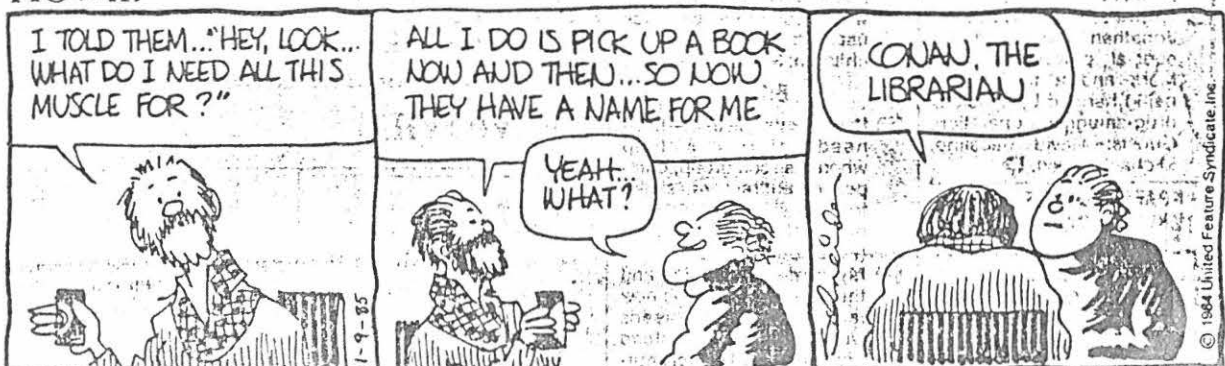
OBESITY(L)SU/MAJ

She said the OBESITY/MAJ(L)SU won't work, and the second example will give you only those that have obesity/maj with su/maj but not those which have obesity/maj with et/maj but su/minor.

This is a very confusing point to clarify, but if you feel you really need to know and you still have questions, I would be glad to talk to you about it. If I can't explain it to you, call Penny at 800-227-1960.
